Age of onset: 40-50²

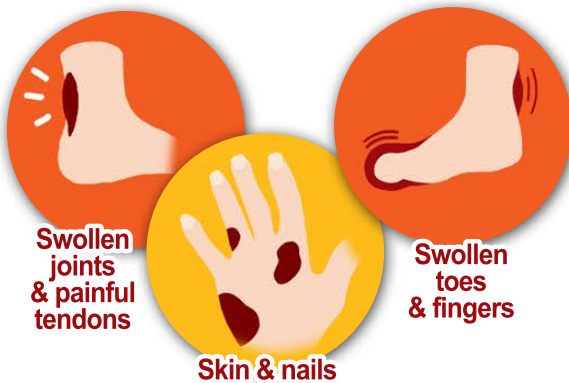

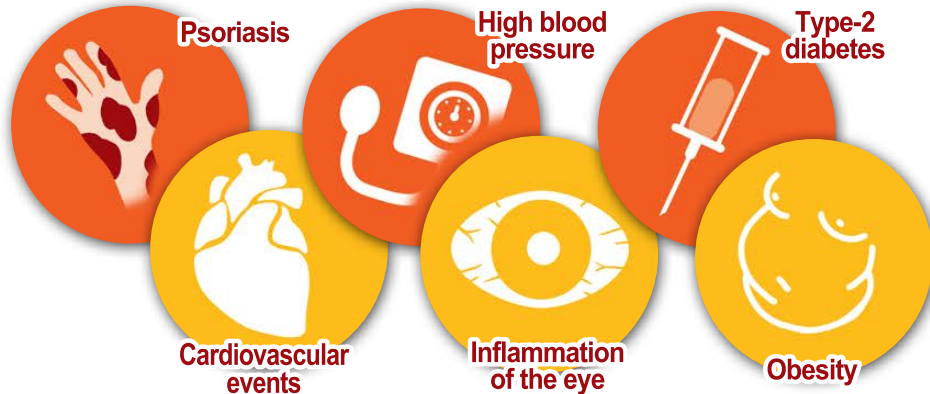
