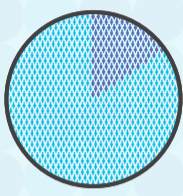


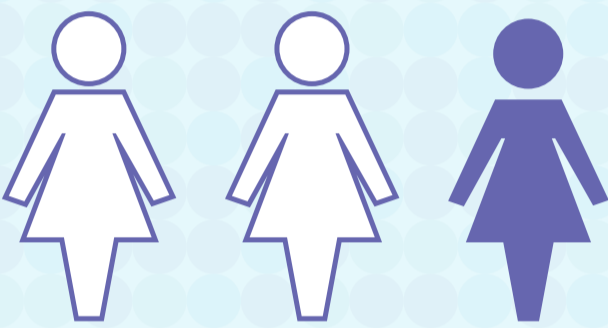
ADVANCED BREAST CANCER BY THE NUMBERS

THAT IS **15%** OF ALL BREAST CANCER DIAGNOSES

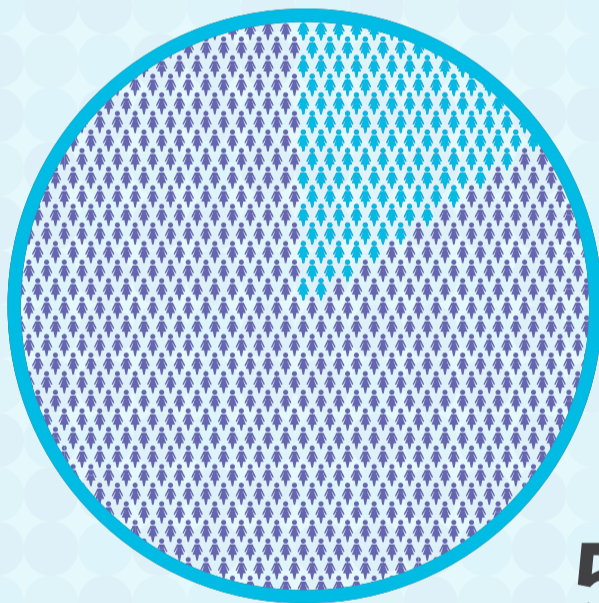
UP TO **11%** OF NEW BREAST CANCER CASES ARE INITIALLY STAGE IV OR METASTATIC
